**Subject:** Ethics complaint filing

Today we are taking the first steps in filing complaints asking the City of Racine Ethics Committee to investigate and sanction the City of Racine Mayor and other administrative staff persons involved in the manipulation and collusion process of our local community access channel CAR25.

Sadly, this is not an isolated incident, but is one example of behavior that has been the standard of a city administration that seems to believe it is not answerable to anyone.

While the issue of CAR25 and the City bidding process are the issue of today, there are many other instances of concern. We request an investigation of the City of Racine's practices, including but not limited to, CAR25 and all other bidding processes that have taken place under this administration.
